



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

V.V.M.'s Govind Ramnath Kare College of Law, Margao-Goa

And

Goa Vidyaprasarak Mandal's Dr Dada Vaidya College of Education, Farmagudi, Ponda

The present Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed on 21-03-2022

By and between

V.V.M.'s Govind Ramnath Kare College of Law, Margao, Goa, affiliated to Goa
University, hereinafter referred to as GRKCL, hereby represented

by its Principal, Dr. Saba V.M. Da Silva

And

Goa Vidyaprasarak Mandal's Dr Dada Vaidya College of Education, Farmagudi.

Ponda, affiliated to Goa University, hereinafter referred to as GVMCOE, hereby represented

by its Principal, Dr. Jojen Mathew.

With the primary objectives of having knowledge exchange, teachers' mobility, sharing of Library and other resources and to broaden the perspectives of the teachers and students of both institutions, the GRKCL and the GVMCOE enter into this formal MoU to promote the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular matters of the Academic Programmes offered in their respective institutions.

Article 1 – Definitions

In this MoU, the following terms when used herein shall have the meanings as provided:

- 1. Faculty Member a teacher by whatever designation, who is appointed on the teaching staff of either of the parties signing this MoU.
- 2. Student A *bona fide* student, duly enrolled in any of the degree, diploma or certificate programmes of the institution, whether undergraduate or post-graduate, which is party to this MoU and includes Research scholars registered at either of the institutions.
- 3. Institution the premises of either of the institutions that are party to this MoU and includes any other place which such institution has taken on hire or gratuitously for the purposes of carrying out the objectives of this MoU.
- 4. Home Institution -the institution in which a respective Exchange Student or Faculty Member is originally enrolled.
- 5. Host Institution the institution in which the respective Exchange Student or Faculty Member is attached for the duration of Exchange Period.

Article 2 - Nature of programmes and scope of collaboration

- At the request of either of the institutions, the other institution commits to organize
 Guest lectures, Master classes, Seminars, Workshops and/or conferences, or any other
 such programme either State, National level or International level with a mutually
 decided schedule.
- 2. Each institution may offer to the other institution opportunities for activities and programmes such as teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, and staff development that will cultivate and develop the collaborative relationship.
- 3. Topics related to issues relevant to Taxation, Business Laws, Human Rights, Education, Environmental studies, Environmental Law, Women's rights, Child rights, Right to Education Act, Right to Information Act (RTI), Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO), Political science, Economics, History as also areas of language development including that of foreign languages, are to be promoted through this MoU.
- 4. To distribute information and guidance for each of the institution regarding the new facilities, research, publications, journals, books, library materials and educational

- resources of the other institution; and to meet yearly for review purposes and evaluate the activities undertaken and to formulate future activities.
- 5. Both parties to this MoU shall jointly certify the participation of teachers and students at programmes and activities conducted in pursuance this MoU. The identity of GRKCL and GVMCOE shall necessarily be reflected in the certificates issued.

ARTICLE 3: GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION

- 1. This MoU shall be identified as the parent document for any activities to be executed between the parties. Further, the terms and conditions concerning any activity shall be provided detailing out specific committees which shall become effective once they are reduced in writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the both parties for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either party from external sources with mutual consent only.
- 2. This MoU is not binding on either institution but is intended to facilitate discussions relative, but not limited, to the following general areas of cooperation. Specific activities and programmes implemented under authority of this MoU shall be subject to availability of resources and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives, and may include; joint educational, cultural, and research activities; exchange of faculty members for research, lectures, and discussions; exchange of advanced professional students for collaborative or independent research.
- 3. Specific funding allocations for the exchange of faculty, staff, and student researchers ("Participating Researchers"), shall be subject to the approval of the respective parties and not as binding as a result of this MoU. The concerned party shall provide assistance and/or the necessary letters of invitation or affiliation to facilitate the visa applications, medical insurance coverage and other such requirements of the country of visit, applicable in the country of the host Participant, for the duration of their visits.

Article 4 - Financial Obligations

- 1. The parties to this MoU conducting a programme or activity in its premises shall bear the expenses being incurred for the same, unless an agreement to the contrary is entered into.
- 2. In case of a programme being jointly conducted, depending upon the magnitude, both parties are required to constitute Committees, comprising members of both parties to this MoU to carry out the programme or activity planned. In such cases, both

parties will approach sponsors, if required and strive to secure funds for the desired purpose.

Article 5 - Regulations of Host Institution

For the purposes of this exchange, the concerned teachers and students are to maintain proper decorum and are subject to the rules of conduct and discipline of the Host Institution.

Article 6- Duration and Termination

- 1. The present MoU shall be effective for tenure of three years from the date of signing the MoU by both the parties.
- 2. Either party may, in its absolute discretion, terminate the MoU by giving written notice of an intention to terminate at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.

Article 6 - Amendments

Any alteration or amendment to this MoU must be made in writing and agreed and accepted by both parties, the GRKCL and GVMCOE.

Article 7 - Applicable Law

Disputes arising out of or related to this MoU shall be resolved amicably by the Principals of the parties of this MoU.
