PREAMBLE

Recognizing the mutual benefits to be gained through a collaborative program promoting scholarly, research activities and international understanding, Eudoxia Education Private Limited, through the Eudoxia Research Centre, and The University of [Partner University] will enter into this academic cooperation agreement. In recognition of the benefits, to be gained through a cooperative program that promotes sustainable scholarly research and contributes to international education, the Eudoxia Research Centre and The University of [Partner University]. The agreement is intended to stimulate and facilitate the scope of the activities of both institutions. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to record formally this mutual interest of Eudoxia Research Centre and The University of [Partner University] in exploring, for a period of five [5] years following signature of this MoU, joint research, training and capacity building to address research opportunities in the India and [partner university's country], for the mutual benefits of both parties and in investigating funding sources to realize these opportunities.







ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION

- 1.1 The areas of collaboration include activities or programs offered at either institution that will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationships between both of the Organizations.
- 1.2 Each institution may offer to the other institution opportunities for activities and programs, such as teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, and staff development that will cultivate and develop the collaborative relationship.
- Organizing, promoting, staffing and coordinating long and short-term staff and student exchanges work-shops, seminars, conferences, leadership programs and other academic activities, provided that all participants are appropriately qualified and there are adequate financial resources.
- 1.4 To receive undergraduate, graduate, post-graduate students and Research Scholars of the partner institution for periods of study and/or research under internship research program. Also carry out joint research and continuing education programs; and exchange information pertaining to developments in teaching, student development and research at each institution leading to publication of research papers, patents and other intellectual properties.
- To distribute information and guidance for each of the institution regarding the new facilities, research, publications, journals, books, library materials and educational resources of the other institution; and to meet yearly for review purpose and evaluate the past activities and to work out new ideas for future development.
- 1.6 Enhancing the capacity of the two institutions to carry out relevant research and to secure the required external funding for same.







ARTICLE 2: GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION

- 2.1 This general Memorandum of Understanding shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the both parties for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either party from external sources with mutual consent only.
- This MOU is not binding on either institution but is intended to facilitate discussions relative, but not limited, to the following general areas of cooperation. Specific activities and programs implemented under authority of this MOU shall be subject to availability of resources and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives, and may include; joint educational, cultural, and research activities; exchange of faculty members for research, lectures, and discussions; exchange of advanced professional students for collaborative or independent research.
- Specific funding allocations for the exchange of faculty, staff, and graduate student researchers ("Participating Researchers"), shall be subject to the approval of the individual Participant and are not binding as a result of this MOU. Except as may be stipulated in any specific subsequent agreement, each Participant shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this MOU.
- 2.4 Each Participant will provide assistances and/or the necessary letters of invitation or affiliation to facilitate the visa applications of Participating Researchers. Participants shall be responsible for ensuring Participating Researchers have adequate medical insurance coverage, applicable in the country of the host Participant, for the duration of their visits.







ARTICLE 3: DURATION, IPR, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

- 3.1 Duration: This MOU shall remain in force for five (5) years from the date of the last signature. Either Participant may terminate this MOU by providing 90 days' advance written notice to the other Participant.
- 3.2 Extension and Renewal. The Participants may extend or renew this MOU by agreement, confirmed in a written amendment signed by each Participant's authorized signatory.
- 3.3 Amendment. No amendment of the terms of this MOU will be effective unless made in writing and signed by each Participant's authorized signatory.
- 3.4 It is understood that activities contemplated under this MOU are expected to be cooperative in nature and that Participating Researchers (including students, faculty, and staff researchers) may collaborate in such research activities for intellectual property development. The "Intellectual Property" or "IP" means all patentable discoveries, innovations, inventions, improvements, devices, equipment, and designs, conceived and reduced to practice under the term of and in performance of this agreement.
- 3.5 Participants hereby agree that ownership of intellectual property rights generated as a result of the activities under this agreement will follow inventor-ship rules in accordance with applicable patent laws. Each Participant to this MOU shall own the intellectual property (IP) conceived and first reduced to practice solely by its employees or agents in furtherance of projects or activities contemplated by this agreement. IP conceived or first reduced to practice jointly by employees or agents of both parties shall be Jointly Owned in accordance with applicable patent laws. "Jointly Owned" means either Participant may exploit jointly developed IP.







- 3.6 It is recognized and understood that this MOU is subject to all applicable export control laws and regulations controlling the transfer of technical information or items out of the respective countries of the Participants. The transfer of certain technical information or items may require a license from the respective governments of the Participants. Participants to this MOU must comply with all applicable export control laws and regulations and no Participant may export or allow the export or re-export of any information or item when to do so would constitute a violation of those laws or regulations.
- Participants agree that adequate safeguards shall be taken whenever using human or animal subjects in research, consistent with applicable laws and policies regarding the use of human and animal subjects, including training of such trainees, faculty, or staff, an institutional review committee, research ethics board, or animal care and use committee composed of members with varying backgrounds who will perform complete and adequate review of projects involving the use of such subjects. Informed consent shall be obtained in accordance with national laws and regulations, international research standards, and accepted guidelines on good research practices and ethics. Each Participant shall, to the extent necessary for the legal conduct of activities under this MOU, comply with the laws and regulations of the other Participant's country.
- 3.8 All the Participants must give all information/notices under this MOU in writing only. All communications must be sent to the official e-mail addresses set for this purpose or to such other address designated by the both of the institutions.
- 3.9 Each Institution represents that the individuals signing this MOU have the authority to sign on its behalf in the capacity indicated.

1. Objectives of the MoU

- iv. To undertake academic activities in the nature of workshops, seminars, talks, symposia, and other similar activities under the banner of Cluster Research Centre in <u>Education</u> for the benefit of researchers and teachers.

2. Terms and Conditions of Collaboration and Sharing of Resources

- i. This collaboration is only for the purpose of establishment of Cluster Research Centre in Education under the relevant provisions of Goa University ordinance and would entail exchange of communication between the participating institutions only so far as required for effective functioning of the Cluster Research Centre in Education.
- ii. The Cluster Research Centre in Education shall be affiliated to Goa University only.
- Only Goa University recognized research guides from these institutions shall be allowed to guide through Cluster Research Centre in Education.
- The responsibility of acquiring approval of Goa University for research guideship shall be that of individual teachers from these institutions.
- v. The recognized Ph.D. guides from the participating institutions shall first register themselves with Cluster Research Centre in <u>Education</u> if they intend to use the platform to enroll candidates for research programmes.

Research guides from the participating institutions shall not canvass for the candidates and shall not resort to activities of competition and malpractice of any nature.

physical and soft infrastructure required for its operation including but not limited to workspace for research scholars, research library, computers, internet infrastructure, NCIPAlatabases, software applications, shall be the responsibility of the individual institution.

- xi. The ownership of any intellectual property arising out of research undertaken through Cluster Research Centre in <u>Education</u> shall be decided by the concerned individual researcher and his/her research guide. The Cluster Research Centre in <u>Education</u> itself shall not have any ownership rights on such intellectual property.
- xii. The institutions shall extend help in conducting activities of Cluster Research Centre in Education.

3. Confidentiality

i. The participating institutions shall maintain strict confidentiality of any information, data or communication of any nature between them with regard to this MoU or operation of Cluster Research Centre in <u>Education</u> and shall not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other institutions.

4. Amendment

 This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of all the participating institutions and the Directorate of Higher Education.

5. Co-ordination Mechanism

In order to ensure smooth functioning of the Cluster Research Centre, the Directorate of Higher Education will constitute a co-ordination committee consisting of

- 1) Principals of the participating institutions
- 2) Supervising guides
- 3) Any other academicians or subject experts nominated by the DHE

7. Framing of Guidelines

The Directorate of Higher Education may frame the guidelines as and when required for the effective implementation of this MoU.

8. Relaxation

The DHE shall be empowered to relax any or all claims or conditions of the MoU in genuine cases.

9. Interpretation

If any question arises regarding the interpretation of any clause, word, expression of the scheme, the decision about the interpretation shall be with the DHE, which shall be final and binding on all concerned.

Article 4. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION AND RESEARCH SAMPLES

4.1 The term "information sharing" includes scientific or technical data, tools, results and/or methods of investigation, methods of teaching and other information intended to be provided, exchanged or arising under the objectives identified under Article 3. The PARTIES shall take all measures to protect the secrecy of and avoid disclosure and unauthorized use of the information which is confidential and outside the public domain.

4.2Knowledge exchanged between the PARTIES shall not be transferred to any third party for research and commercial purposes and that the unutilized portions of such samples must be sent back to the concerned coordinators.

Article 5. PUBLICATIONS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

5.1 Any research publications and intellectual property rights arising out of the students and joint research projects shall be jointly published and, when patented, will be jointly and equally owned by GVMDDVCOE and VMSCL.

5.2 The procedural formalities for securing and maintaining the intellectual property rights shall be the responsibility of both GVMDDVCOE/ VMSCL and the expenditure incurred thereof shall be borne jointly and equally by GVMDDVCOE and VMSCL

5.3 The upfront fee and royalty accrued from licensing of any intellectual property arising from this collaboration to other PARTY (IES) shall be shared between the PARTIES, the terms and conditions of which shall be the subject matter of a separate agreement between the PARTIES.

5.4 The PARTIES shall not assign any rights and obligations to any third PARTIES without consent of the other party.

Article 6. IMPLEMENTATION

- 6.4 The convener and co-convener shall be the contact persons for all the cooperation and other related issues identified in this understanding.

Article 7. FINANCE

7.1 Each PARTY shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither PARTY shall make a claim against the other PARTY for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES.

Article 8. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 8.1 Research instrumentation, infrastructure and library facilities available at the PARTIES work place(s) shall be made available to the teaching faculty, research scholars and students of the PARTIES.
- 8.2 The PARTIES shall not use any of the confidential information which is required to be held in confidence for any purpose other than performance of their obligations under this understanding.
- 8.3 The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation identified under Articles 2 and 3 shall be subject to the availability and convenience of research students, faculties and infrastructure facilities available at the PARTIES work places.

- 8.7 All questions related to this understanding arising during its term shall be settled by the PARTIES by mutual agreement. The disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to the respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified.
- 8.8 Nothing in this understanding is intended to affect other cooperation or collaboration between the PARTIES.
- 8.9 All the collaborative activities pursuant to this agreement shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations governing GVMDDVCOE and VMSCL
- 8.10 Both the PARTIES will discuss the finances, resources shared based on the project protocols and other formalities.

Article 9. ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND TERMINATION

- 9.1 This MOU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the PARTIES and shall be valid for the academic year 2020 21. This understanding may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either PARTY upon one month's written notice to the other PARTY.
- 9.2 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this agreement may be continued until their completion under the terms of this understanding.

Article 10. AMENDMENTS

10.1 This MOU represents the entire understanding between the PARTIES and supersedes any and all understandings either oral or written hitherto with respect to the subject matter of this understanding.

10.2 No amendment or modification of the MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the PARTIES and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of the MOU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MOU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed unless otherwise agreed to.

11.1 This MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each PARTY and hence neither PARTY shall transfer or assign this agreement or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

Article 12. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

12.1 The relationship of the PARTIES under this understanding shall be non-exclusive and both PARTIES are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular education, training and research agreement, the participants may agree to limit each PARTY's right to collaborate with others on that subject.




