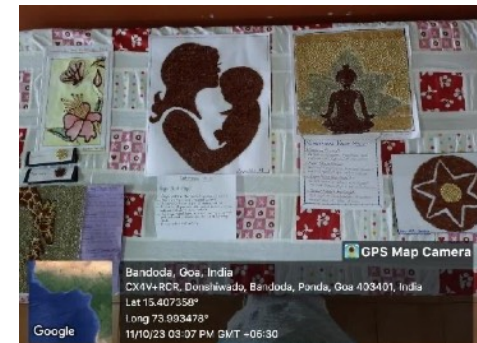

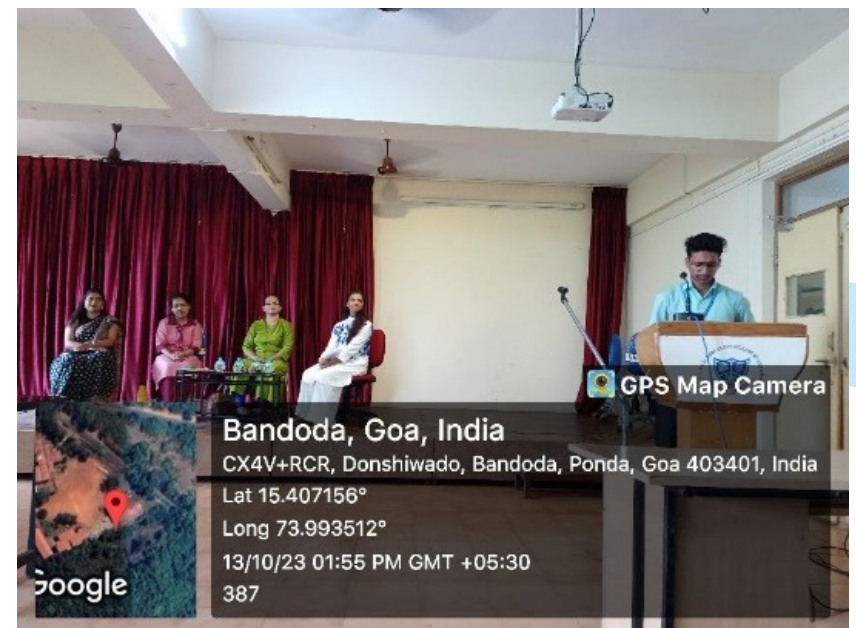
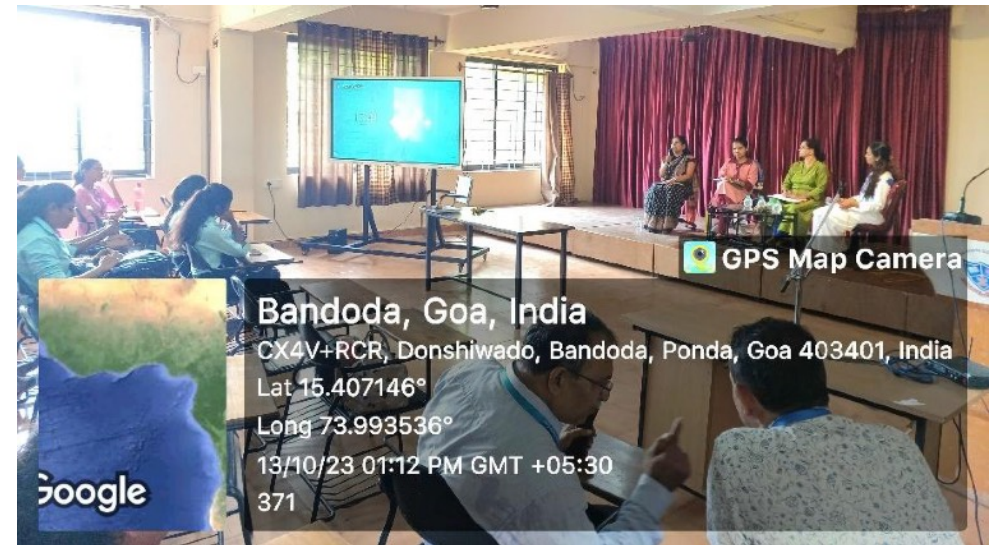
## International Year of Millets & International Girl Child Day, 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023

Millet Rangoli Competition was conducted on the theme "Empowering Girls: Unleashing their potential" on the occasion of International Girl Child Day" for the B. Ed students. A quiz on Millets was organized where students participated and competed in groups. It helped to create awareness about millets among students. The Millet Recipe Competition- The Millet Recipe Competition was organized where 33 students presented novel varieties of millet recipes and explained how the nutritional value of food items gets enhanced by using millet as an ingredient. The Pre-Primary department organized the activity and students participated in the competition.



## Panel Discussion- Power of Mindfulness and Self Care, 13<sup>th</sup> October 2023

The panel discussion was held on the topic Power of Mindfulness and Self-talk to bring awareness among the students about mindfulness practices. Though many are becoming aware of this topic and practicing being mindful there is still a rise in impatience and intolerance among the students. The aim of the panel discussion was to motivate students, share mindfulness tools, and understand how their internal dialogue with themselves affects their actions and life. The panel consisted of a Grade 1 teacher (Mrs. Archana Shetye, college student (Ms. Deepika Narvekar and counselor (Ms. Sumedha More) so that the audience connects with the experiences and makes the most of them. The program was compered by Ms. Suhana Vanti, moderated by Ms Swarnim Chopdekar and a Vote of thanks was proposed by Mr. Aditya Singh. 99 students were present for the program. The panelists shared their experiences and gave tools to practice mindfulness, highlighting that consistency is important in any practice one follows.





## Workshop on Pronunciation Skills, 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> October

A two-day Workshop on Pronunciation Skills was organized by Assistant Professor Akshata Samant, under the skill development course of EDU-06 Communication Skills for F Y B. Ed students, on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October, and Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2023 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The resource person for the Workshop was *Shri Vallabh Verekar, (Retired Teacher and Headmaster) presently serving as the Coordinator of the Diploma in Pre-primary Teacher Training program at GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education.*

The Workshop on Pronunciation Skills formed a part of the input for the topic, *'Introduction to the Sounds of English- Vowels, Diphthongs and Consonants- Pronunciation, Articulation, Intonation, Diction and Stress', under the Oral Communication Unit of the Subject EDU 06 Communication Skills* and served in partial fulfilment of the practical assignment based on the said topic.

17<sup>th</sup> October, day one of the Workshop was dedicated to the importance of pronunciation skills as a universal concept, followed by a video clipping on most mispronounced words in English with the view of developing awareness about the nature of the English language. Vallabh Sir later explained the concept of pronunciation, Phonetics, and phonemes. On day 2 of the workshop the practice of vowel sounds and related examples was done with the help of an interactive board. Diphthong sounds and symbols with related words were practiced aloud, firstly modelled by the teacher and followed by a whole class drill and practice. Vallabh Sir explained how error correction with the school students or learners needs to be subtle but constructive. A handout was given as a home assignment. Overall, the two-day workshop was very fruitful and all the students certainly benefited from the practical insights received during the sessions. The entire program was efficiently coordinated by EDU-06 subject in-charge Assistant Professor Akshata Samant.





## Peace Education, 18<sup>th</sup> October 2023

Youth Peace Foundation Organized a Video session on "Peace Education" on the 18th of October 2023 at 10.15 a.m. Sir Vinayak Naik was the resource person. 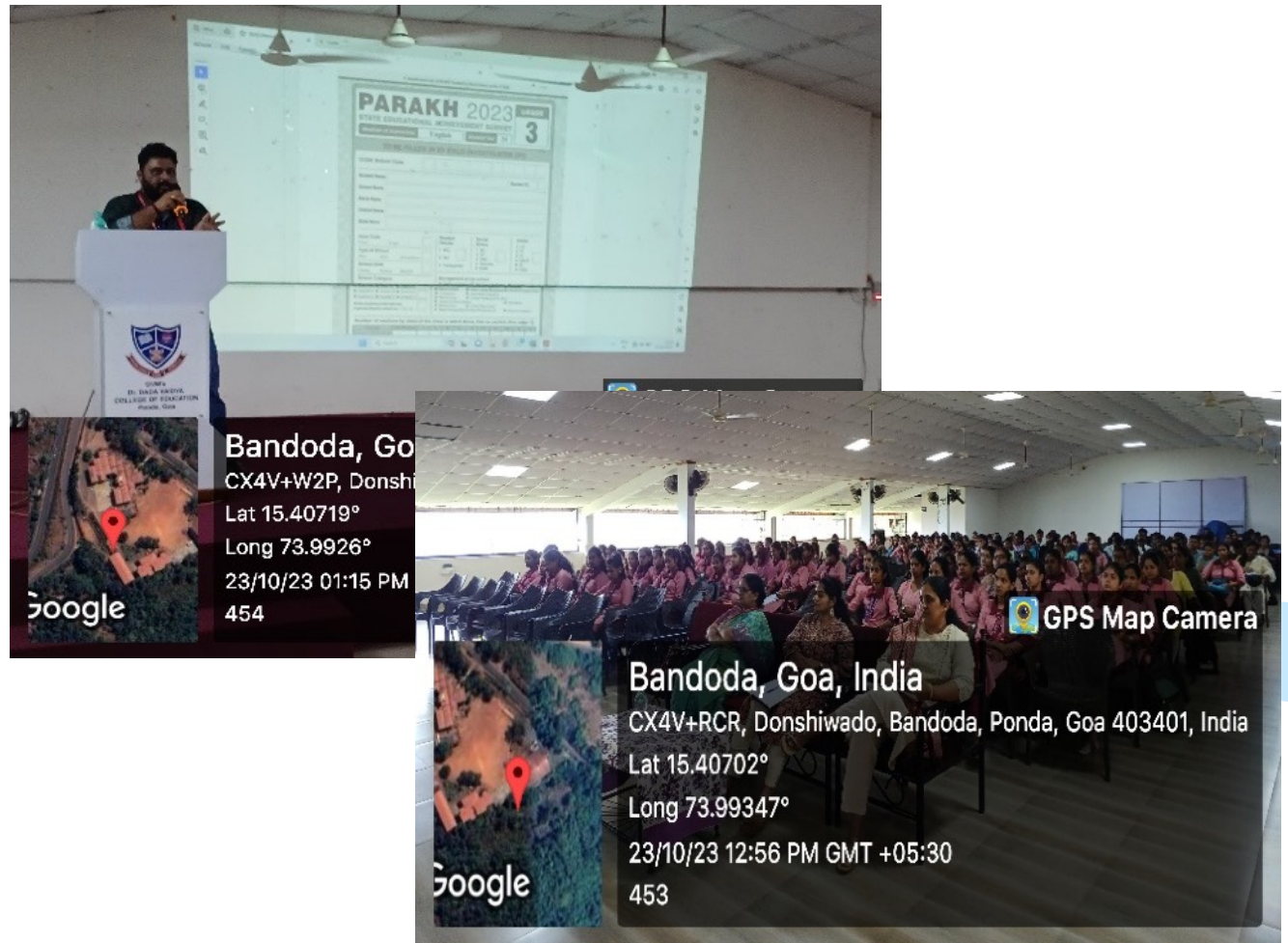

The program was efficiently coordinated by SEAS, 2023 College Coordinators Akshata Samant and Dr. Honey Babu.



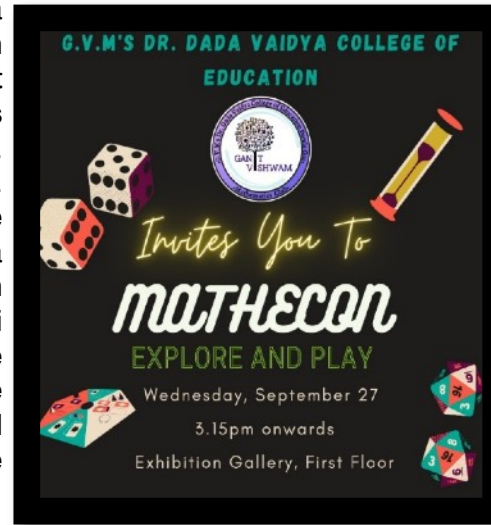


## Mathematics Games Competition “MATHECON”, 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023

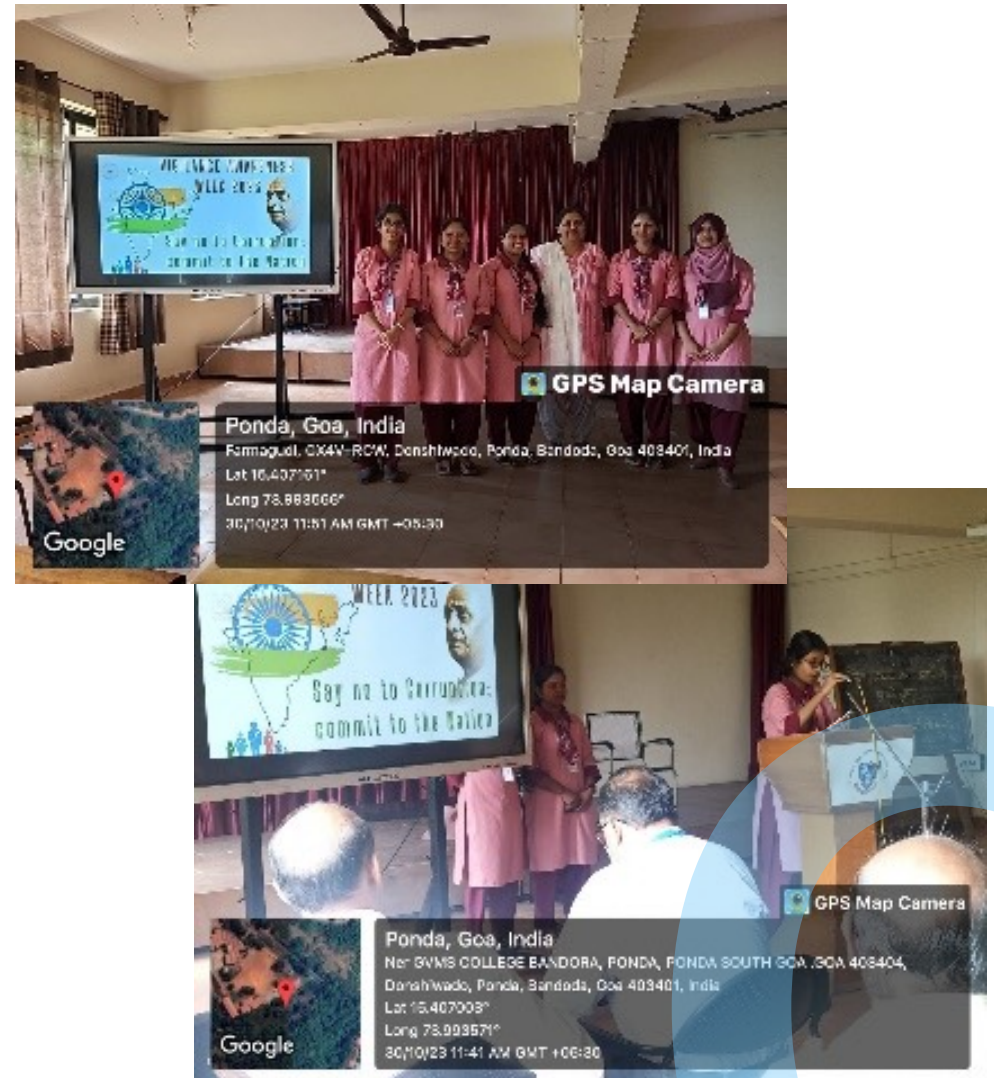




## Sensitization Program-Vigilance Awareness Week, 30<sup>th</sup> October to 5<sup>th</sup> November

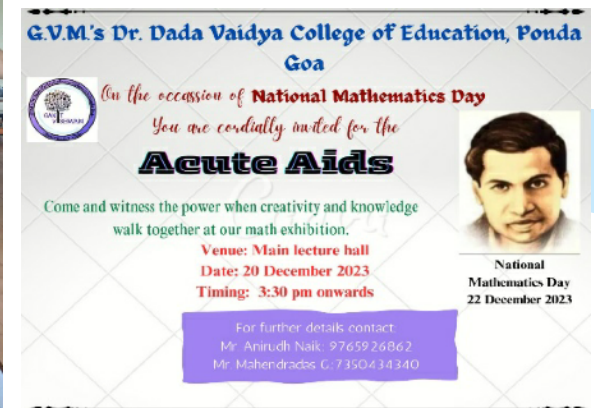


## Mathematics Teaching Aids Competition- ACUTE AIDS on the occasion of National Mathematics Day, 20<sup>th</sup> December 2023

## Celebration of National Youth Week from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2024

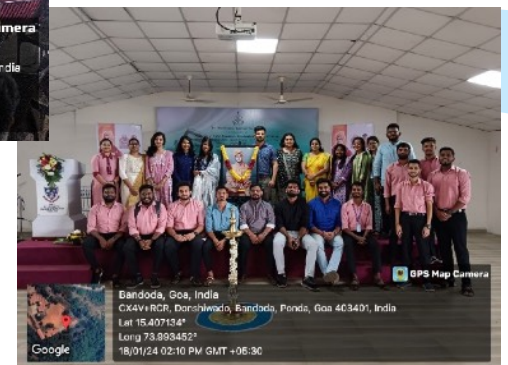

## Inter-Collegiate Bollywood Singing Competition: 'Voice of GVM's'

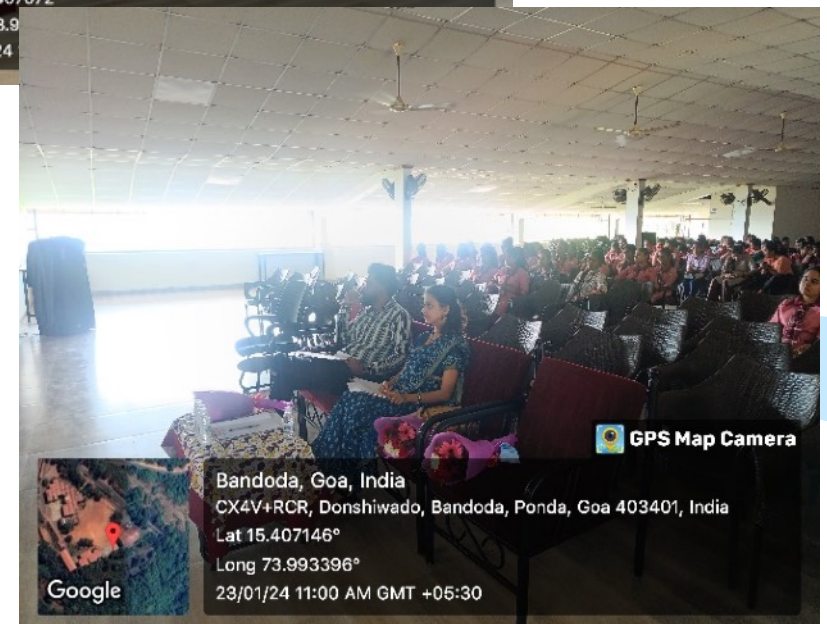
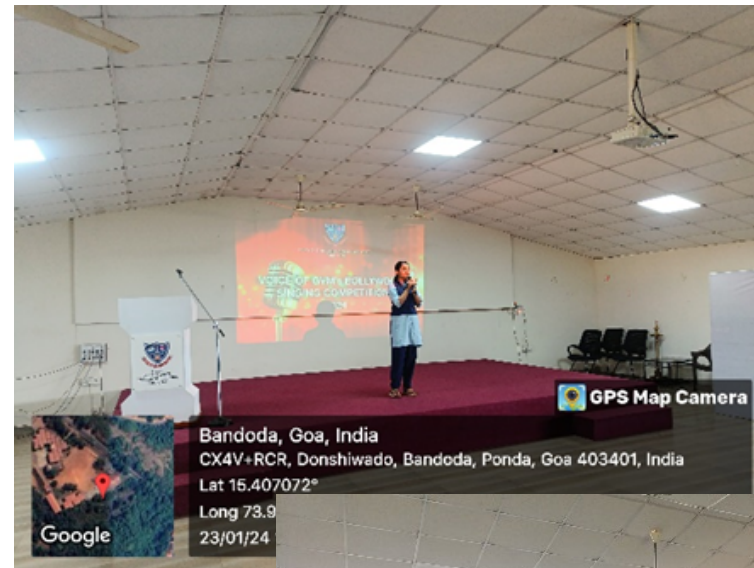

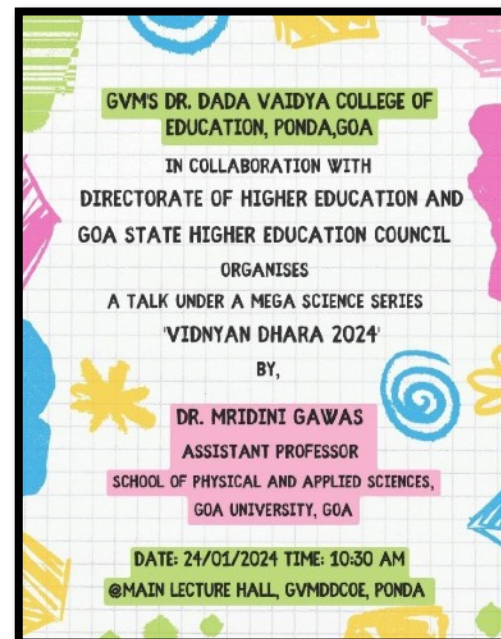

## **Awareness Talk on 'POSH Act- What Students Should Know', 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024**

An awareness talk was organized by the College in collaboration with V. M Salgaoncar College of Law, Miramar, Panaji Goa. on 31st January 2024, from 10:00 am to 11:00 am. The topic of the awareness talk was, "POSH Act- What students should know". The Chief Guest and Keynote speaker of the program was Dr. Sandhya Ram S. A., Associate Professor, V. M Salgaoncar College of Law. The Guest of Honor of the Program was Dr. Poornima Usgaonkar, Associated with Dilasa Centre for Terminally Ill, Ponda & IMA Ponda Charitable Trust (Member External).

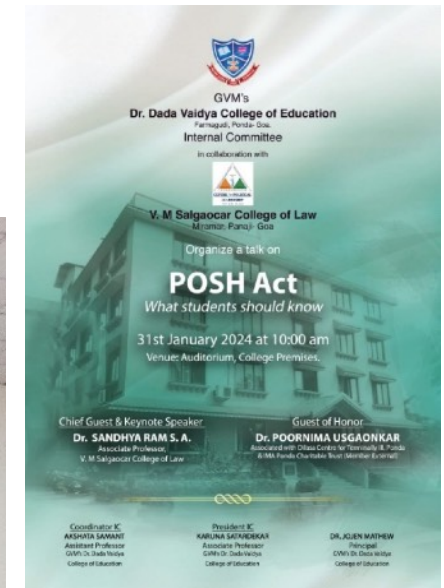
The Guest of Honor Dr. Poornima Usgaonkar, Associated with Dilasa Centre for Terminally Ill, Ponda & IMA Ponda Charitable Trust (Member External), in her inaugural address, shared her words of advice based on her years of clinical practice. She shared valuable insights regarding the care that each student can take to lead a respectful and safe life in society.

Dr. Sandhya Ram S. A., Associate Professor, V. M Salgaoncar College of Law delivered a very engaging lecture on "POSH Act- What students should know". POSH Act, 2013 & UGC regulations, 2016 Know your law was the main focus of the session. She enlightened the students on the Sexual harassment of women at the Workplace (Prevention Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2013. Helping students and staff understand the rationale behind why legal protection (from SH) only for women she provided the reasons for the same. Giving the factual backdrop she mentioned that sexual harassment is one form of gender discrimination. Giving the details of the Vishaka judgment in brief, she explained what the Law says prevention, prohibition and redressal. Dr. Sandhya provided an overview of the POSH Act 2013 in conjunction to UGC (Prevention Prohibition & Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2015. The key elements of sexual harassment at the workplace were illustrated with examples of what constitutes sexual harassment. She explained the concepts of 'student', 'employee', and 'campus'. The Grievance Redressal Mechanism was explained in detail, followed by the composition of the Internal Committee, the confidentiality aspects as per 8.16 of POSH Act. She further shared the details of who can file a complaint, how, and when to file a complaint. Punishment, if found guilty, compensation and action against false complaint was discussed. The responsibilities of the Internal Committee were explained with the responsibilities of HEI. Finally, the supportive measures were explained in detail.

The program was held for the students of FY B. Ed, S Y B. Ed, M. Ed, and Diploma in Pre-Primary Teacher Training Program and was attended by all the staff members of the College. The program was coordinated by Internal Committee Member Akshata Samant, Assistant Professor GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education, Ponda Goa.

The program was very informative not only for the students but also for the staff members. It not only created awareness but also instilled a sense of responsibility amongst the audience at large.





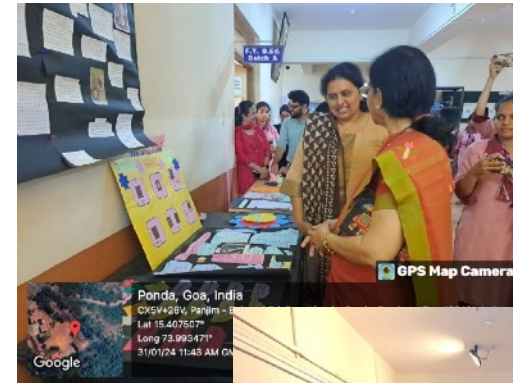
## Teaching Aids Exhibition- Methodology of Teaching English, 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024.

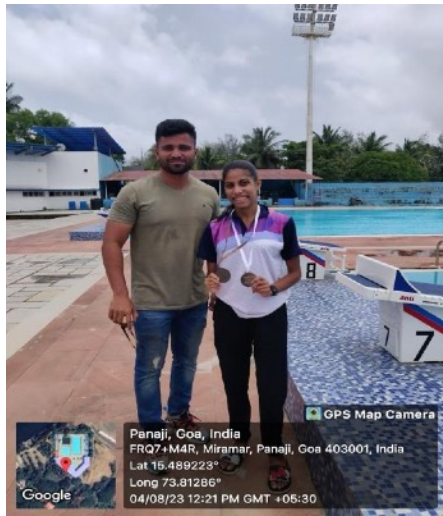

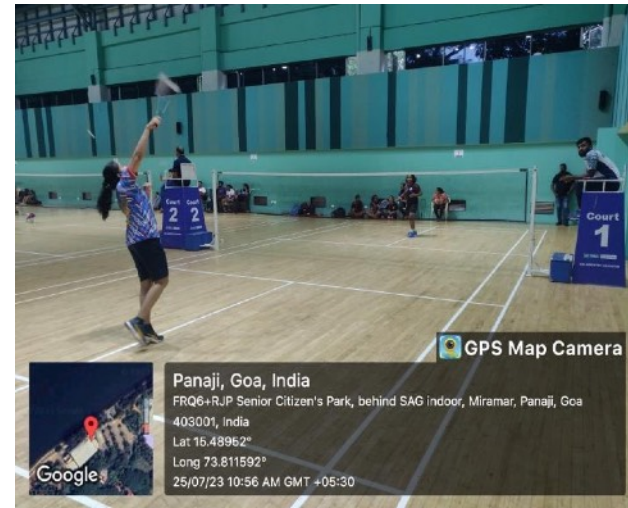
