About the College

GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education, situated in Ponda Taluka was established in the year 1993 in response to the growing demand for teacher education in Goa. The college is affiliated to Goa University and is recognized by National Council of Teacher Education. The College offers B. Ed, M. Ed, Ph. D (Education) and Diploma in Pre-Primary Teacher Training. For all the courses it is expected that student teachers are groomed into all round Teachers. For this, Curricular, Co-Curricular and Research activities are organized throughout the academic year. Highlights for the Month of October

International Day of Non-violence, 29th September to 4th October 2021.

'In Commemoration of the International Day of Non-violence' on 2nd October 2021, GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education, Farmagudi, Goa, organized a week-long program, from 29th September to 4th October 2021, with its culmination in the form of an Exhibition held on 4th October, showcasing the work of the students done over the week. The celebrations kicked off on 29th of September by observing the Khadi Day/ Swadeshi / Organic Day and with the administration of the 'Pledge on Non-violence and Peace' to all the students as well as the staff members. On 30th October an orientation was given by the program coordinator Assistant Professor Akshata Samant, regarding the various activities that students had to participate in. On 1st October, screening of the Film- Attenborough's Gandhi was done followed by an Online Quiz on International Day of Nonviolence held on 2nd October. To perpetuate the cause of valorisation of regional languages, a few activities were done either in English, Hindi, Konkani or Marathi. The week-long program culminated with a formal function and an exhibition which was held at the College Auditorium on 4th October 2021(following all COVID related SOP's), wherein the B. Ed students delivered speeches on Non-Violence and Peace, followed by a group Peace Song and the formal speech by Principal Dr. Jojen Mathew.

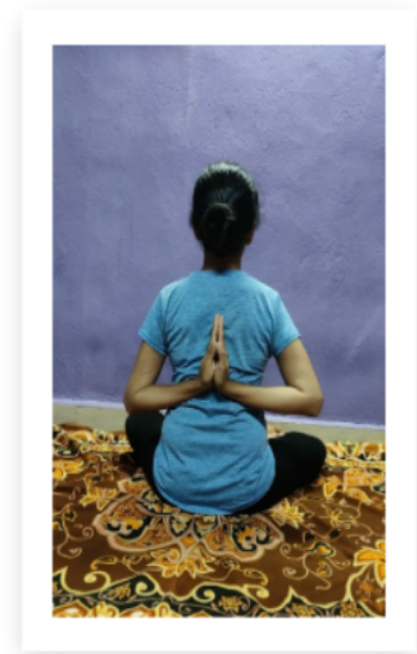
“FIT INDIA MOVEMENT”, 13th August 2021 to 2nd October 2021.

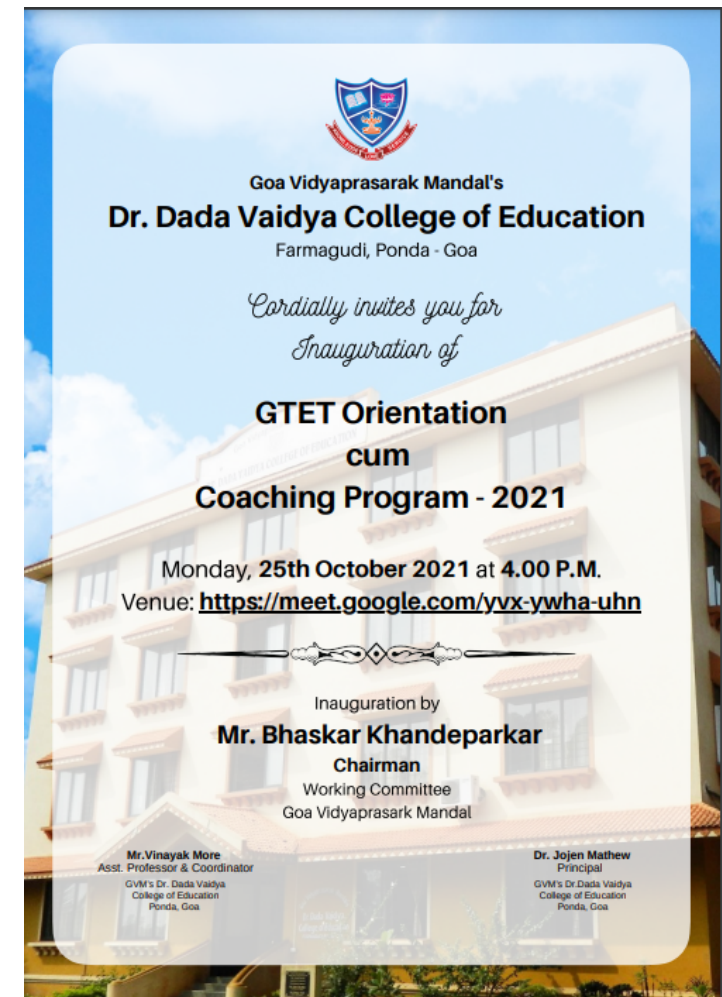

GTET Orientation cum Coaching Program, 2021- 25th October 2021 19th November 2021.

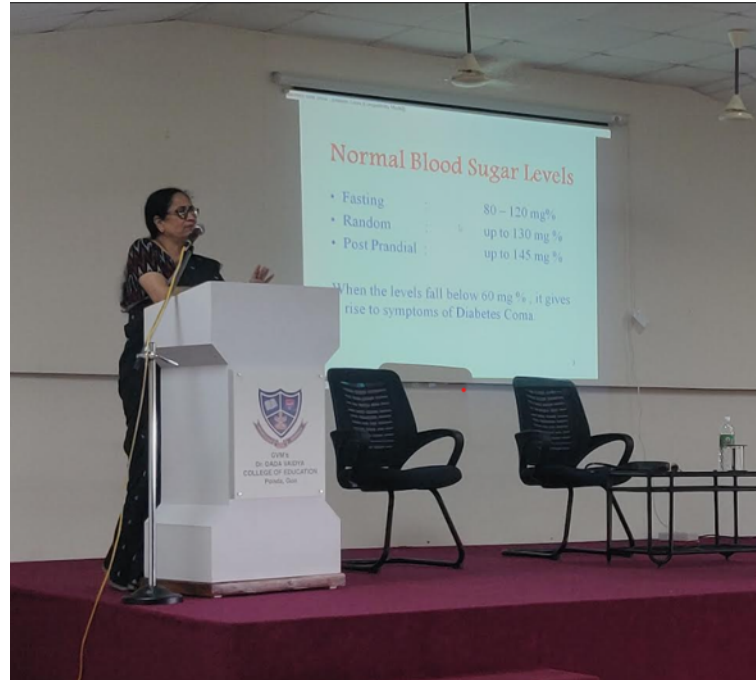
In accordance with the provisions of subsection 1 of section 23 of the RTE act, NCTE has laid down passing Teacher Eligibility Test as the minimum qualifications for a person to be eligible for appointment as a teacher for class 1st to 8th. In response to this SCERT, Goa conducted States first ever Goa Teacher Eligibility Test (GTET) on 21st of November 2021. GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education facilitated regular and ex-students with 'Orientation cum Coaching Program-2021' which was co-ordinated by Assistant Professor Vinayak More. The entire program was conducted free of cost for the students. In all 176 students enrolled for the program and more than 120 students completed the coaching program. We are proud to say that 68 students who qualified for GTET-2021 were from this batch.

'Folk Traditions of Goa', by Dr. Pandurang Phaldessai, 16th December 2021.

On the behest of DHE, Government of Goa, the College organized a lecture on "Folk Traditions of Goa" was delivered by eminent resource person Dr. Pandurang Phaldesai, on, Thursday, 16th December 2021, from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm, which was attended by 16 faculty members and 107 students. Sir emphasized the fact that the cultural roots of a society need to be conserved and propagated through generations. This can be done, keeping in mind four basic principles of, Bhui Mata, Prakruti Mata, Gomata, and Bhasha Mata. He reiterated that language is the vehicle of transmission of culture. While the folk traditions of Goa are rich and varied. The Sanskriti of any society and for that matter the Goan society, is expressed through art, be it music, dance and theatre. Dr. Pandurang Phaldesai beautifully illustrated examples of Folk music (Gaun Kani, Banwaad, Ovi, Pancharati, Panchvadya) and accompanying traditional Lok Vaadya like Ghumat, Zaanj, Mhadale etc. He also spoke of the Folk dances performed during Dhalo, Shigmo, Pingli, Fugdi, Zembada, Mel (Marshal art music), Goph, Povade Karavlya, Ghode Modni, Mando, Dulpad (Fusion of Goan and Portuguese traditions) Dekhni, Cazarnaach, Intruj, Musla Khel (Victory dance of Yadav Kaalin). Sir further explored Folk Theatre like, Jagor Shashti Khel – Natkuli performed during Carnival., Shankasura kalo, Dashavatari Natak and a few other popular Folk theatre Forms. Dr. Pandurang Phaldesai concluded his lecture by underlining the importance of conserving the Goan folk tradition and the role the trainee teachers need to play in its propagation. He spoke about his publications "Typological Insights into Folklore of Goa" which documents his invaluable work.

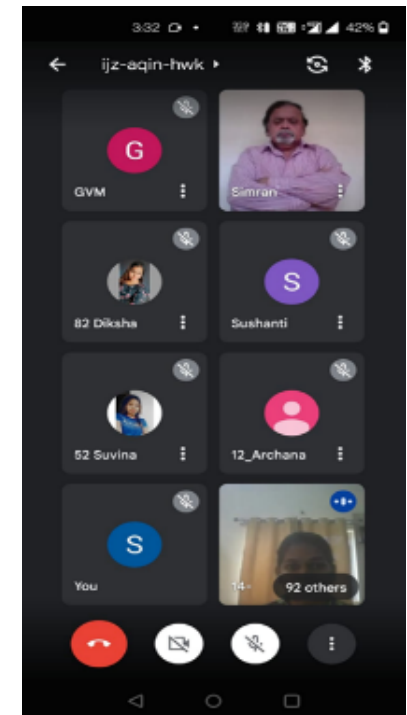

Basic Counselling Skills Course, 12th February 2022

Counselling and Career Planning Centre in collaboration with Extension Service Department launched 30 hours online Basic Counselling Skills Course on 12th February 2022. The classes were held every Saturday for 3 hours from 10am to 1pm. There was total 21 participants from different educational institutions. The participants were in-service teachers and to be teachers.

The course syllabus was designed by the college Counsellor Ms Swarnim Chopdekar under the guidance of Ms. Honey Babu and Dr. Jojen Mathew. The course aimed to prepare the participants to inspire change than just convey knowledge about counselling skills. The content was delivered through videos, role plays, powerpoint presentation and games. Participants learned about skills every counsellor must have, therapies, how to work with students of different ages, how to deal with crisis like suicide, pandemic, sexual abuse, and grief. Resource persons were also invited to conduct few classes and rest of the classes were conducted by the college Counsellor.

At the end of the course, a test was administered on 30th April 2022 through google form. Certificates were given based on the active participation in the sessions and test performance. 17 participants received certificates. Feedback was collected from the participants and the response was great.
